

Chippewa Falls Noon Kiwanis Club

The Chippewa Falls Noon Kiwanis Club will award \$500 scholarships to one graduating senior from the Chippewa Falls Senior High School and one graduating senior from the McDonell Central High School, with an additional two \$500 scholarships being awarded to a graduating senior from the Chippewa Falls Senior High School, the McDonell Central High School, or a Home School graduate residing within the Chippewa Falls School District. The scholarship will be awarded to applicants who plan to continue their education at a college, university, or technical college.

Kiwanis is a worldwide service organization appealing to men and women who have the desire to become personally involved in improving the quality of life within their communities. Kiwanis voluntarily share the challenge of community improvement and leadership, assuming responsibility for humanitarian and civic projects. Scholarships will be awarded to applicants that have demonstrated this. Although we believe that class rank is important, we will not consider it in our selection.

Instructions for applying:

1. Type all information on 8½ x 11 sheets of paper.
2. Provide your full name, address, telephone number and high school.
3. List by name and year (9, 10, 11, 12) the activities you have been involved in at school. Indicate the approximate time commitment each month for that activity.
Example: Student Council Representative (12; 7 hours/month)
Worked on Yearbook (12; 4 hours/month)
Spanish Club (9, 10, 11, 12; 6 hours/month)
4. List by name and year (9, 10, 11, 12) participation in volunteer activities in your church and community. List the approximate time commitment for each activity.
Example: Hospital Volunteer (11,12; 6 hours/month)
Pure Water Days Volunteer (12; 20 hours)
Taught Sunday School (12; 10 hours/month)
Active 4-H Member (9, 10, 11; 6 hours/month)
5. Write an essay – no more than two pages, typed, double-spaced – describing the career goals you have chosen. Talk about your hopes and dreams for your future.
6. Include one letter of recommendation from someone directly associated with one of the community service projects listed on the application. (Submit one recommendation letter per scholarship application.)
7. Scholarships will be awarded to recipients at the senior awards ceremony at their respective schools. Each recipient will be asked to attend a regular Kiwanis Club meeting (noon -1:00pm at the Avalon Hotel) to be recognized for their achievement.
8. To be considered, applications must be postmarked no later than Friday, April 19, 2017.
